
Experiential Network

What is Experiential Network?

The Experiential Network (XN) provides organizations with the opportunity to work with talented students on short and long-term projects. This arrangement enables organizations to move forward on project-based work at no cost while giving students highly relevant work experience and real-world learning opportunities.

How Does It Work?

Project work is done virtually over six-week sessions (with some flexibility), with sponsor-mentors dedicating about an hour per week to providing feedback. Projects are typically research based and conclude with an actionable deliverable that provides insight and recommendations to inform critical business decisions. Projects are embedded in students' coursework as assignments and/or capstone projects. Long-term engagements like co-ops and internships are also available.
